The Bubba Mac Shack originated in Somers Point, NJ as a restaurant and Blues club. Bubba and his son Mac opened the famous Bubba Mac Shack seven years ago. Bubba has played music all his life and has been in blues clubs all over the world. They envisioned a club of their own to bring together all the great acts in one place. Bubba and Mac's goal was to create a restaurant that was New Orleans-meets-South Jersey. Upscale but down home. The Shack built for musicians encompassed 5 bars and 3 stages. In the course of those seven years, hundreds of nationally recorded blues acts rocked the Shack day and night. Due to the notoriety of the Shack, a TV show was created called "Live at the Bubba Mac Shack". The show providing clips of great blues and music acts performing live on one of the clubs three stages. The show also included performances by the Bubba Mac Blues Band as well as cooking segments. A year ago the second Bubba Mac Shack opened up seasonally on the boardwalk in Ocean City, NJ. During this time the Bubba Mac Blues Band played many festivals and cosponsored others. From all these experiences Bubba and Mac decided to create and present the Mid-Atlantic Blues and Music Festival in Atlantic City, NJ. To ensure its success, they have enlisted the support of Paul Benjamin from the infamous North Atlantic Blues Festival in Rockland, ME. As you can see from the lineup, the festival has the best of the best.
